Overview: The North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services Office of Rural Health (ORH) is committed to improving access to quality, affordable health care for persons residing in the state's rural and underserved areas. ORH leverages the North Carolina Conrad 30 J-1 Visa Waiver Program to increase the number of physicians practicing in rural and underserved areas. ORH serves as the "interested government agency" for the Conrad 30 program; however, ORH provides letters of recommendations for the US Department of Health and Human Services Exchange Visitor Program and the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) J-1 Visa Waiver Program.

The Conrad 30 J-1 Visa Waiver program affords international medical graduates (IMGs) on J-1 visas the opportunity to waive their two-year home-country physical presence requirement in exchange for three years of medical service to patients in Health Professional Shortage Areas (HPSAs). Annually, the State of North Carolina receives 30 J-1 visa waiver slots per year (October 1 -September 30). To ensure North Carolina's primary care needs are met, 10 of the 30 slots are reserved for primary care physicians (including Hospitalists) practicing in Family Practice, General Internal Medicine, General Pediatrics, Obstetrics/ Gynecology, or Psychiatry in HPSAs. NC has 92 counties designed as primary care HPSAs and 93 counties designated as mental health HPSAs. Up to 10 slots may be used for physicians to work in areas which are not designated as a HPSA. These 10 slots are called FLEX slots. To ensure full utilization of the J-1 Visa waiver slots, ORH utilizes 10 of the Primary Care waiver slots for specialists not practicing Primary Care and providing at least 32 hours per week in direct face-to-face patient care in a HPSA. Slots are filled with eligible applications on first come, first served basis. The importance of the Conrad J-1 Visa Waiver Program in addressing community needs is reflected in feedback received during stakeholder meetings held across NC to gather input on this critical program.

Over the last 5 years, ORH placed primary care and subspecialist physicians in underserved areas of North Carolina in the following specialties: Family medicine, internal medicine, pediatrics, psychiatry, surgery, hospitalist, cardiology, oncology and many more.

Using IMPLAN models, each provider specialty is found to be associated with a different economic impact to communities, ranging from \$586,423 for a Pediatrician to \$1,201,712 for an OBGYN. ORH recognizes the need for a diverse team of providers in each community in North Carolina, a value that reaches beyond the estimated economic impact.


