The North Carolina Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Crossroads system will release a new software version (1.30) to local agency users on Monday, July 24, 2023. This document summarizes the improvements included with the upgrade.

I. Anthropometrics/Lab work Deferral


Under the American Rescue Plan Act Waivers (ARPA), if height/weight information is not available, it may be deferred for up to 60 days. If bloodwork information is not available, it may be deferred for up to 90 days. If bloodwork is deferred, the risk codes 401 and 428 cannot be used. See WIC Program Manual Chapter 6, Section 3 for more information.

If deferred, all other relevant nutrition assessment information (i.e., nutrition and breastfeeding practices, clinical data, etc.) must be collected at certification. Risk code assignment is necessary to complete a certification therefore at least one code must be assigned. Local agencies should continue to make reasonable efforts to try to collect this data even after the 60-day period has ended so that, if needed, the nutrition risk codes can be updated, and the nutrition education appropriately tailored.

Crossroads has been modified to reflect the ARPA Anthro/Lab deferral.


Anthropometrics Deferral

Select the **Deferred Reason** "Physical Presence Waiver" in the Height/Weight container on the **Anthro/Lab** screen. The **Measurement Date**, **Height** and **Weight** fields will gray out (but the stars will remain next to the fields). If Lab measures are required, complete the lab container. Select **Save**. The star to the left of the Quick Links list will turn into a green check mark.




Bloodwork Deferral

Select the **Deferred Reason** "Physical Presence Waiver" in the Bloodwork container on the **Anthro/Lab** screen. The **Bloodwork Date**, **Hgb** or **Hct** fields will gray out (and the stars will disappear). If anthropometric data is required, complete the Height/Weight container. Select **Save**. The star to the left of the Quick Links list will turn into a green check mark.



Deferred Anthro/Lab Report

The **Deferred Anthro/Lab Report** will list any participant who has a deferred Height/Weight and/or Bloodwork value for certifications within the From/To dates specified in the search parameters. This report is accessed from the Clinic Report Category.



Use the following search parameters:

From/To Date: Certification dates for participants with deferrals

State: North Carolina WIC Program Report Type: Clinic OR Local Agency

The report lists Family ID, Participant ID, Participant Name, Certification Date, Reason for: Bloodwork Exemption, Bloodwork Deferment, and/or Heigh/Weight Deferment, and Bloodwork Due Date. See Sample on next page.

II. CVB Amounts Effective October 1, 2023

Cash Value Benefit (CVB) values will continue at the amounts listed below until any federal guidance is issued regarding CVB values or any other rate. Starting July 25, 2023, all participants receiving CVB benefits with a First Date to Spend (FDTS) on or after October 1, 2023 must have a new prescription that includes the below CVB amounts. Select the green plus sign on the Issue Food Instruments screen added in Crossroads.

Starting with FDTS of October 1, 2023, each WIC participant (excluding infants) will receive Cash Value Benefits (CVB) in the following amounts based on WIC Category:

- \$25.00- Child
- \$44.00- Pregnant

Non-Breastfeeding

Breastfeeding (Fully Formula Feeding)

Partially Breastfeeding (PBF) > Maximum Monthly Allowance (MMA)

• \$49.00- Breastfeeding PBF ≤ MMA

Fully Breastfeeding

Pregnant with two or more fetuses

• \$73.50- Breastfeeding multiple infants from the same pregnancy

Reminder: On the **Exchange/Increase** formula screen, current Crossroads functionality is:

- Add Formula DOES prorate.
- Exchange Formula does NOT prorate.
 Formula is exchanged on an ounce for ounce basis (Reconstituted Fluid Ounces, not can/container size).
- Increase Formula does NOT prorate.
 Please contact the CNSS Customer Service Desk (CSD) if you need the amounts of an increased formula to be prorated.

Best Practice for eWIC! Always verify that food benefits have been issued to participants by selecting the **Print Shopping List** button on the **Food Instrument List** screen and reviewing the **Shopping List**. Verification of food benefit issuance is a best practice that should happen at any appointment when food benefits are issued, voided, exchanged, replaced or increased. Missing or incorrect food benefits can be corrected by contacting the CNSS CSD.
