Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP)

DISCLOSURE ON UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS SCSEP PARTICIPANTS INELIGIBLE FOR UI

The Senior Community Service Employment Program meets the conditions in the state of North Carolina to exclude SCSEP wages from Unemployment Insurance. In accordance with 20 CFR, Part 641.565 (B) (4) of the Senior Community Service Employment Program; Final Rule, unless required by law, sub grantees of SCSEP may not pay the cost of unemployment insurance for participants. Participants must meet the state requirements for wages earned or time worked in order to be eligible for benefits. Since SCSEP participants work in community service assignments, taxes should not be imposed for the purpose of paying UI benefits.

SCSEP participants are provided community service employment, which is parttime, temporary, work-based training, paid for by U.S. Department of Labor funds. The service provided as a SCSEP participant is not considered employment for purposes of unemployment benefits. Therefore, upon exiting SCSEP for any reason, you are not allowed to file a claim for unemployment benefits based on your SCSEP experience.
