Subject: Multiple LME-MCO Locations in Provider Files

The purpose of this email is to provide guidance to LME-MCOs regarding continuing to serve beneficiaries even when their Medicaid cards reflect an alternate LME-MCO location.

The Division of Medical Assistance (DMA) recently learned of an issue with provider data NC FAST uses to link beneficiaries to an LME-MCO. Each LME-MCO has one address and phone number which is printed on recipient Medicaid ID cards. The address and phone number is included in a file from NCTracks to NC FAST. NC FAST assigns beneficiaries to an LME-MCO, not the county DSS.

Recently, the file from NCTracks included the address and phone number for multiple alternate locations for some LME-MCOs. This caused beneficiaries to be assigned to one of the alternate locations. The alternate address and phone number is printed on Medicaid ID cards. It is returned in the recipient eligibility response.

Please continue to serve beneficiaries linked to your LME-MCO as always, even if their ID cards have the address and phone number of an alternate location. Capitation payments are paid to the provider ID, so this should not affect your capitation payments. DMA, The Office of NCTracks, NC FAST and CSC are working to resolve the issue as quickly as possible.
