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INTRODUCTION

In recent years there have been two separate reports(Annual Statistical Report for LMEs and the Admissions Report for LMEs) that have provided descriptive statistics and trends in the public community mental health system in North Carolina. In an effort to provide a single source of information that adequately describes the type of clients served at the clinical, demographic and geographic level these two reports have been combined into a single report for State Fiscal Year 2019. While similar in format and table construction to the previous reports, the intent of this report is to provide an integrated look at major service indicators and measures.

Client Activity and Utilization (Table I) reflects admission rates, active caseload at the beginning of the fiscal year, total admissions and the total number of persons served by the LME-MCO. There were 254,889 active cases on July 1, 2018 and 90,301 total admissions (first and readmissions combined) during the fiscal year. A total of 345,190 persons were served during fiscal year 2019 as indicated by adding first and readmissions to the active cases (excluding those on Inactive Status and TASC Clients) on July 1, 2018. Graph 1 depicts the number of clients served at the LME-MCO for the last ten years.

Admission rates reflect the total number of admissions to an LME-MCO during the fiscal year per 100,000 population in the catchment area. Admission rates are useful in that they allow comparisons among geographic areas as well as special population subgroups by adjusting the effects of population size. Admission rates were selected instead of utilization rates because of their greater accuracy.

The statewide admission rate was **859** admissions per 100,000 population. The admission rate ranged from a low of **391** per 100,000 reported by Alliance Behavioral to a high of **1,343** per 100,000 population reported by Trillium.

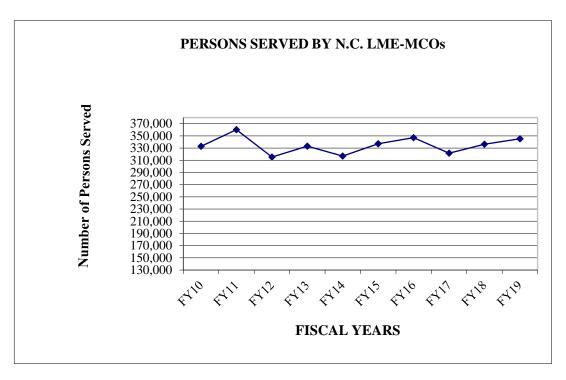

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This graph reflects the number of persons served by the 7 LME-MCOs for the time period FY2010 through FY2019. This data reflected in this graph does not include persons on inactive status.

A total of 345,190 clients were served by LMEs during FY2019 representing a 3.72% increase over the 332,796 during FY 2010.

TABLE 2

Table II reflects the number of persons served in each of the LME-MCOs by age and disability. The age of the client was calculated as of 6-30-19 and the disability of the client was based on the diagnosis assigned to the client on the NCTRACKS paid claim.

A total of **371,077** persons were served in the LME-MCOs and TASC during FY19. Persons Served is calculated by totaling the active caseload on July 1, of the fiscal year (excluding those clients on Inactive Status) and all admissions.

Of the **371,077** clients served, **69** percent (**257,103**) were mentally ill, **4.84** percent (**17,955**) were developmentally disabled, and **25.88** percent (**96,019**) were substance abusers. Within each disability the percent of children served (0-17) ranged from **0.49** percent (**469**) of substance abusers, to **21.87** percent (**3,927**) of the developmentally disabled. The percent of children served in the mental health category was **13.55** percent (**34,840**).

The data reflected in this table included admissions by diagnosis and marital status. The aggregate groupings of diagnosis are based on the ICD9 and ICD10 (International Classification of **Diseases**, 9th **Revision Clinical Modification**, International Classification of **Diseases**, 10th **Revision Clinical Modification**)

Of the diagnosis reported at the time of admission, substance abuse (39,439) accounted for (35.1%) of all admissions. However, when looking at Psychiatric Diagnosis only, which represented (54.38%) of all diagnosis, major depressive disorders (18,928) accounted for (16.8%) of all admissions. There were (9,703) alcohol abuse admissions which accounted for (8.6%) of all admissions.

In the marital category, the largest group is those who are single, representing **69.7%** of all admissions.

The data in this table reflects admission characteristics by race, sex and age categories.

Males represented the majority of the total admissions **59.8%** with females representing **40.9%** of the total admissions.

When looking at race categories during FY19 non-white admissions numbered **41,431** or **36.8%** of the total reported. Of the non-white admissions reported **1.5%** was American Indians.

The age group composition of LME-MCO's admissions reflects that **30.8%** fell within the 25 to 34 age group. When admissions are grouped by the three major age groups, **10.5%** were 0-17, **88.0%** was between 18-64 years of age and **1.5%** were 65 years and older.

Table 3B reflects the duplicated number of admissions for each of the LME-MCO's by age and disability. The age of the client was calculated on the admission date and the disability of the client was based on the diagnosis assigned to the client on the NCTRACKS Paid Claims.

Of the 112,502 clients admitted, 54.38% (61,175) were mentally ill, 1.04% (1,171) were developmentally disabled, and 44.58% (50,156) were substance abusers. Within each disability the percent of children served (0-17) ranged from 0.97% (486) of substance abusers, to 52.95% (620) of the developmentally disabled. The percent of children served in the mental health category was 17.45% (10,677).

Table 3C reflects the unduplicated number of admissions for each of the LME-MCO's by age and disability. The age of the client was calculated on the admission date and the disability of the client was based on the diagnosis assigned to the client on the NCTRACKS Paid Claim.

Of the 107,510 clients admitted, 55.93% (60,128) were mentally ill, 1.08% (1,165) were developmentally disabled, and 42.99% (46,217) were substance abusers. Within each disability the percent of children served (0-17) ranged from 1.02% (472) of substance abusers, to 52.96% (617) of the developmentally disabled. The percent of children served in the mental health category was 17.66% (10,620).

The relationships described for admission diagnosis remained true for termination diagnoses, although absolute numbers and percentages changed. Substance abuse accounted for **37.9%** of terminations versus **35.1%** of admissions. Adjustment disorders accounted for **4.1%** of terminations versus **4.6%** of admissions while major depression disorders accounted for **14.6%** versus **16.8** % at admission.
