

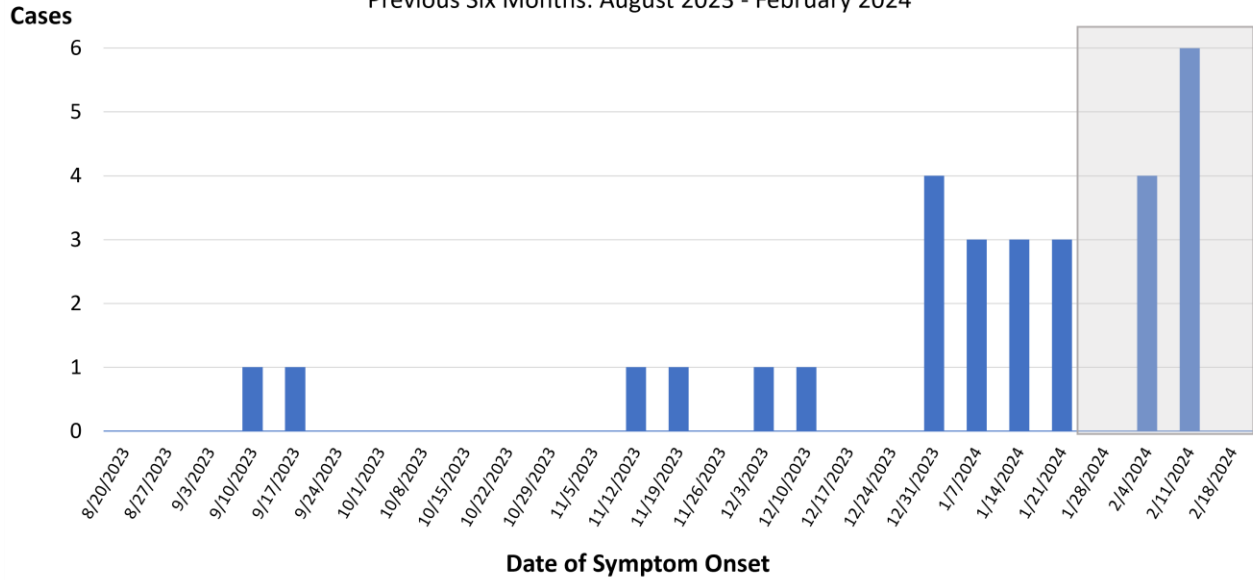

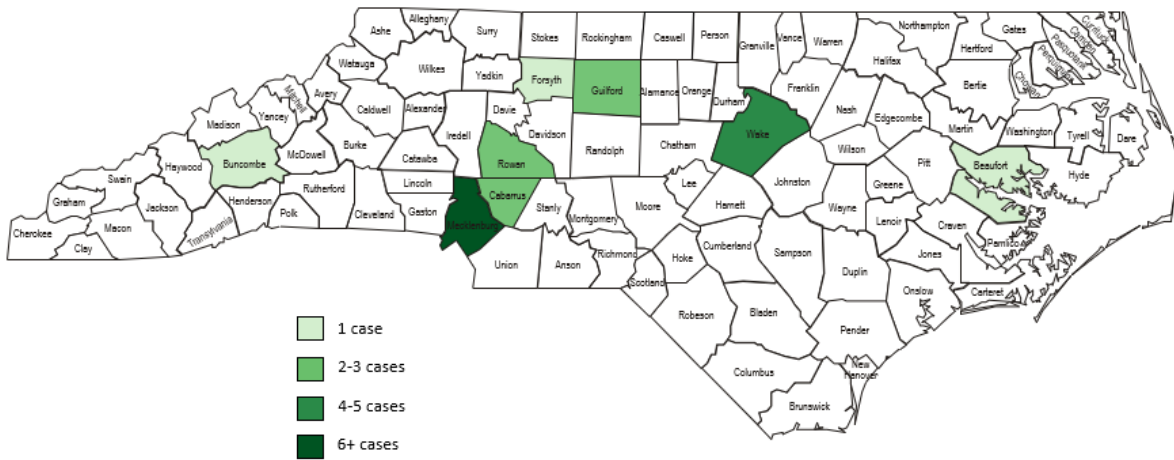


Figure 1: Mpox Cases by County, Previous Six Months: August 2023 – February 2024
