- **SUBJECT:** Revisions to the State-Funded Community Living and Support Service and the Sunset Extension for Community-Based Day Services for Individuals with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) or Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)
- **DATE:** September 22, 2023
- **CONTENT:** Revisions to Community Living and Support and Sunset Dates of the related services in the Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (I/DD) Benefit Plan

A revision has been made to the State-Funded I/DD and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) Community Living and Support (CLS) service definition based on feedback from providers and LME/MCOs.

Billing should be completed as follows for the residential services below:

• Individuals NEW to the Residential Supports service should enroll in Residential Supports (Levels 1-3) and utilize the appropriate NCTracks procedure code based upon assigned level effective immediately. (Residential Supports, Level 1 – YM846, Residential Supports, Level 2 – YM847 and Residential Supports, Level 3 – YM848).

• Individuals with I/DD or TBI CURRENTLY enrolled in the following services may transition to Residential Support (Levels 1-3), Supported Living Periodic or another available service by Sept. 30, 2023. Upon transitioning to Residential Supports Level 1 - 3, the expectation is to utilize the appropriate NCTracks procedure code. The current NCTracks procedure codes below will terminate and will no longer be billable in NCTracks after Sept. 30, 2023.
