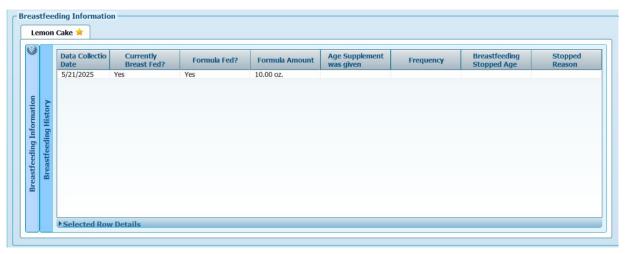
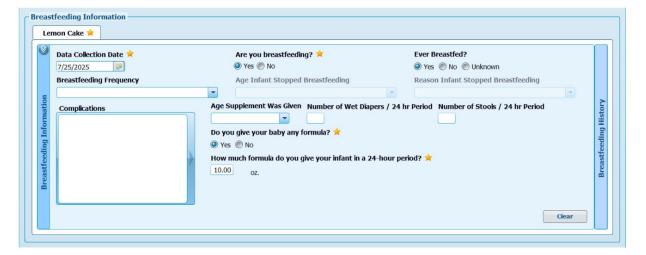
The North Carolina (NC) Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Crossroads system will release a new software version (1.36) to local agency users on Monday, August 25, 2025. This document summarizes the improvements included with the upgrade as well as important notes about functionality changes.

Breastfeeding Information container retains last answers entered

For the question "Are you breastfeeding?" the **Breastfeeding Information** container on the **Health Information** screen will default to the most recently saved values—regardless of whether the participant is currently breastfeeding or not—for the infant(s) currently linked to the mother's record. In other words, the fields displayed in the **Breastfeeding Information** container will reflect the data from the most recent row in the **Breastfeeding History** container with the exception being the Complications. The selected complication(s) and associated risk code(s) will be available on the participant's **Care Plan Detail** screen.

Support for Future Revised Food Packages

The 1.36 upgrade includes support for the future configuration of the Revised NC WIC Food Packages. The following feature will be visible but not operational on the **Prescribe Food** screen:

Participant Food Purchase Report

A new feature on the Crossroads **Prescribe Food** screen allows users to download a **Participant Food Purchase Report**. This report can be used to demonstrate the monetary value of WIC food benefits to the family and to guide discussions about tailoring the food package based on items that were NOT redeemed. MyNCWIC Portal MultiFactor Authentication (MFA)

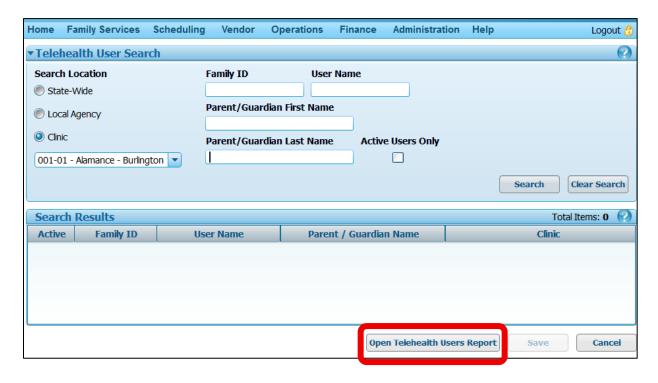
The **MyNCWIC Participant Portal** will require multi-factor authentication (MFA) starting August 25, 2025. In addition to entering login credentials, the portal user will be required to enter a confirmation code, which can be sent to them by authenticator, email, phone call or text message. Telehealth User Maintenance Report

A button has been added to the Crossroads **Telehealth User Maintenance** screen that enables users to download a **Telehealth Users Report**. This report includes a list of every family that has successfully logged into the MyNCWIC Participant Portal using an Individual NCID. This report contains the following columns:

- WIC ID
- User Name

- Parent/Guardian Name
- Start Date
- Last Login Date
- Active/Inactive

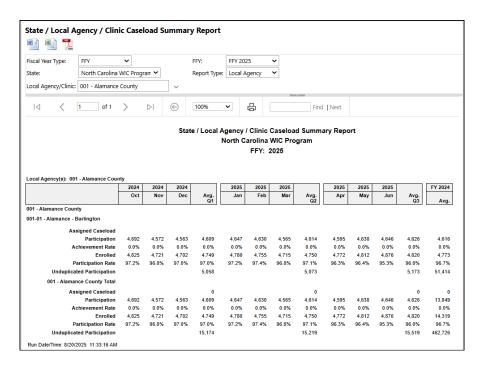


MyNCWIC Communications: Documents viewing error
