SUBJECT: National Medical Support Notice Changes

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Effective September 29, 2025, North Carolina Child Support Services (CSS) will implement a change to the electronic National Medical Support Notice (NMSN) in the NC Child Support Worker Portal. The gender field will be limited to two options: M – Male or F – Female.

Key Changes When Submitting an NMSN electronically:

- Unknown (U) or blank will no longer be accepted in the Gender field for any participant.
- Only F (Female) or M (Male) will be accepted in the Gender field.
- If the gender field is blank or has Unknown (U), a red error message will display on the worker portal, and you will be unable to proceed to the next step. You must update the Sex field on screen C2A in ACTS (Automated Collection & Tracking System) to either F or M, and then return to the NC Child Support Worker Portal to submit the NMSN electronically.
