SUBJECT: RAPID RESPONSE TEAM (RRT)—NEW REFERRAL PROCESS (FOR PHASE 2 COUNTIES)

PURPOSE: The purpose of this notice is to announce the Phase 2 rollout of North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS) ServiceNow Rapid Referral Team (RRT) Tracking system for child welfare service teams. As stated at the onset of Phase 1, the ServiceNow RRT system provides a central location for local teams across the state to interface electronically on RRT referrals and affords NCDHHS the ability to better track trends that the local teams are encountering.

The ServiceNow Rapid Referral Team Tracking System replaces the RRT Word form and manner in which the form and LME/MCO weekly updates are to be submitted to NCDHHS (i.e., formerly via the Rapid Response email, rapid.response.BehavioralHealth@dhhs.nc.gov). Several counties, as part of Phase 1, have full access to the new system: Beaufort, Buncombe, Catawba, Cumberland, Durham, Gaston, Guilford, Mecklenburg, Rockingham, Stokes, Wilkes, and Wake counties. The next iteration of counties, 45 in total, to have staff convert to using the new ServiceNow RRT system begins on January 22, 2024. The Phase 2 counties are:
