PURPOSE: COURT: ROLES AND OBLIGATIONS OF FOSTER PARENTS | A LEARNING SITE FOR NC FOSTER AND ADOPTIVE PARENTS AND KINSHIP CAREGIVERS

On September 1, 2021, Session Law 2021-132 was enacted which established new training requirements for foster parents. As part of the licensure process, foster parents must complete a pre-service training that includes a module, created, developed, and made available by the Department which explains the roles and obligations of foster parents in judicial proceedings. <u>The new module, *Court: Roles and Obligations of Foster Parents*, is now available.</u>

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The module, *Court: Roles and Obligations of Foster Parents*, discusses the roles of key players in court, types of court hearings in child welfare, responsibilities of foster parents, and the Foster Parents' Bill of Rights. It is an online, self-paced training available on FosteringNC.org, and is accessible 24/7. IMMEDIATE ACTIONS:

<u>Beginning May 1, 2022</u>, all **new** foster parent application packets will be required to have a certificate of completion included for each person applying for licensure.

<u>Current licensed foster parents</u> will need to complete this course as part of the re-licensure process and the certificate of completion must be submitted with the re-licensure packet.

COURSE AVAILABILITY:

County child welfare agency social workers and private agency social workers can complete the module on FosteringNC.org beginning April 18, 2022. All social workers who work with foster parents are strongly encourages to complete the course. For county child welfare agency social workers, the completion of this course will county towards required annual training hours. The course will also be available on NCSWLearn in the future.
