

## Caring For Our Own Kinship Caregiver Support



Children's Home Society of NC has a dedicated kinship team that works in partnership with kinship families and their DSS social workers to locate, and enroll in, Caring for Our Own groups that are offered online throughout the year. There are both evening and daytime groups from which to choose. **Caring for Our Own** is a kinship support and training group that provides a convenient way for families to gain support with the experiences common to kinship care.

Through a series of **ten online meetings**, kinship caregivers will learn how to assess and build on the strengths and needs of the children in their care and gain assistance and ideas for working in partnership with the helping network, the children, and birth parents.

This group includes additional content that meets the preservice training requirement for licensure in North Carolina, and there is *no cost to families* to attend.
