In 2015, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) was signed into law, reinforcing support for disadvantaged and high-need students, including those in foster care. ESSA provisions complement the Fostering Connections to Success and Increasing Adoptions Act of 2008, together promoting collaboration between education and child welfare agencies to ensure school stability and academic success. To meet ESSA requirements, the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) enhanced protections for these students and began tracking their academic performance. DPI partnered with the SERVE Center at UNC Greensboro to support local education agencies and ensure compliance with ESSA through technical guidance and implementation support. North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Department of Social Services (NCDHHS DSS) and NC DPI will be hosting a joint conference in November 2025 for child welfare agencies and local education agencies to have the opportunity to learn directly from state partners, a peer panel, and guest speakers with lived experience. After completing the workshop survey, attendees will earn a certificate for 8 contact hours and gain access to electronic tools and printable resources to support their work.
