NC Family Foster Parent Pre-Licensure Training Curriculum

Prior to the beginning of training, Licensing Staff should:

- 1) Show parent(s) how to access the Self-assessment and have them complete it.
- 2) Show parent how to access the "Expanding Your Parenting Paradigm" and "Overview of Child Welfare System" online theme and have them watch the video (1 hour, self-guided)

Both will be referenced in the first session, so it is important that they complete them in preparation for training Training Structure:

- -Training is based on 30 hours and 6 of 30 hours are self-guided modules.
- -Note Trainings can be done in-person, virtually or hybrid. Pre/Post tests to be completed after each theme, can be completed electronically, must be provided to the trainer and submitted to the state to Cynthia.ogle@dhhs.nc.gov. Fidelity forms are filled out by the trainer after the delivery of the themes then submitted to the state to Cynthia.ogle@dhhs.nc.gov

Right-Time Trainings delivered as instructor-facilitated group sessions must include the completion of Pre/Post tests for each theme. Instructors are required to follow the conversion instructions outlined in the Right-Time Training Guide for Support Group Leaders when adapting the content for group delivery. The Pre/Post tests can be completed electronically, must be provided to the trainer, and submitted to the state to Cynthia.ogle@dhhs.nc.gov.

Instructor facilitated pre-licensure training can be completed in increments of 5, 7, 10, 14, etc. sessions at agency discretion. All training hours must be completed in the order listed below.
