ATTACHMENT: Q&A-TRANSITION TO MAPP FOUNDATIONS

Beginning in February 2026, NCDHHS DSS is transitioning from TIPS-MAPP to the revised course MAPP Foundations. To kick off the transition, six (6) events of the one-day course *TIPS to Foundations: MAPP Certification* will be offered in February and March to currently certified NC TIPS-MAPP Leaders.

Who can attend the one-day certification?

- Only certified TIPS-MAPP Leaders can attend the TIPS to Foundations: MAPP Certification.
- Those who were certified in MAPP-GPS and did not update their certification to TIPS-MAPP do not qualify to attend the one-day *TIPS to Foundations: MAPP Certification* and must complete the 8-day *MAPP Foundations (Model Approach to Partnerships in Parenting) Leader Certification*.

What should I expect during the one-day certification?

- The course will be from 8:30am-5pm.
- Lunch will be on your own.
- Leader guides and binders will be provided. As a reminder, the books are large. Please plan accordingly.

I was enrolled in a TIPS to Foundations event in August-October that was cancelled. What do I do?

- Find the event that best suits your needs and submit an application via https://ncswlearn.org/. Be sure you have permission from your supervisor.
- NCDHHS DSS will ensure that all who were previously enrolled are enrolled in one of the rescheduled cohorts.

Should I apply for more than one event to increase my chances of attending?

• No, please only apply for your first choice.

How many staff can attend the one-day certification from each agency?

• NCDHHS DSS will prioritize 2 staff from each agency. We encourage co-leaders to attend together, if possible.

Who will be prioritized for enrollment?

 Agency supervisors sent lists to Barbara Young, MAPP Curriculum Coordinator, prioritizing staff to attend the one-day certifications. Those priority lists will be honored, unless otherwise directed by an agency supervisor. • As a reminder, agencies that have more than one location should limit two staff from each location.

I am an agency supervisor and have had staffing changes that impact enrollment. What do I do?

I completed the MAPP Foundations Leader Update directly through Children's Alliance of Kansas, do I need to attend this Leader Update?

• Yes, the curriculum has changed.

What is the transition period?

- The deadline for all TIPS-MAPP Leaders to be recertified is **September 30, 2026**.
- Agencies can continue offering TIPS-MAPP until September 30, 2026, or until staff are recertified in MAPP Foundations. Once staff are certified in MAPP Foundations, the expectation is that the agency only delivers MAPP Foundations moving forward.
- Effective October 1, 2026, TIPS-MAPP will no longer be an approved preservice option for foster home licensing.

Will there be more opportunities for TIPS-MAPP Leaders to update their certification to MAPP Foundations?

 Yes. NCDHHS DSS will offer more leader certification update sessions throughout the transition. Additional cohorts after June 2026 will be posted on NCSWLearn and announced in the Blueprint once scheduled.

When will the 8-day MAPP Foundations (Model Approach to Partnerships in Parenting) Leader Certification be available for those not certified in TIPS-MAPP?

 New leader certifications have been scheduled and are available for application via www.NCSWLearn.org.
