SUBJECT: SPECIAL ASSISTANCE CLUSTER TRAINING

The Division of Aging and Adult Services (DAAS), Special Assistance (SA) Unit, has scheduled state-wide cluster training for September and October 2018. This training goes beyond the basic policy and was developed from evaluation of monitoring results and from most asked ListServ questions. It will provide additional guidance to Special Assistance eligibility staff with processing SA cases in NC FAST and expand upon basic Special Assistance policy.

Each county has been assigned a date and designated location. There is no registration cost, and pre-registration is not required. The training will be conducted from 9:00 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. with an hour lunch break. (Lunch is not provided.) Because of limited space, we request counties send a maximum of five (5) individuals. It is highly recommended that county supervisors, leads, and training staff attend.

Attached is the training schedule which also identifies the training location to which each county is assigned.
