Subject: SFY 10-11 County Funding for the Home and Community Care Block Grant (HCCBG)

Date: May 3, 2010

Attached, please find the SFY 10-11 Home and Community Care Block Grant funding for your county. SFY 10-11 HCCBG Instructions and updated formats are posted on the Division of Aging and Adult Services website at http://www.ncdhhs.gov/aging/cobudget/cobudgdn.htm. Currently, statewide SFY 10-11 HCCBG funding is approximately 102.45% of SFY 09-10 funding. However, the General Assembly will be convening on May 12 to address the SFY 10-11 budget and the Division will follow up with any necessary funding revisions upon authorization of the budget later this summer. Through the Intrastate Funding Formula, all counties will continue to receive no less than 95% of their SFY 04-05 HCCBG funding, pending availability of funding.

The Intrastate Funding Formula factors and weights remain unchanged from previous years. Formula factors are as follows: Age 60+ general population (50%); 60+ low income (30%); 60+ minority (10%); and 60+ rural (10%).
