Dennis Streets / Jar W you Update on SFY 11-12 Funding Subject:

Since March, the Division of Aging and Adult Services (DAAS) has advised area agencies on aging that the current SFY 10-11 Home and Community Care Block Grant (HCCBG) funding should be the planning basis for SFY 11-12 county funding. Area agencies are now to notify counties that the current SFY 10-11 funding will be the SFY 11-12 HCCBG award until DAAS allocates SFY 11-12 funding. This notification is to be made no later than Wednesday, June 1. Current HCCBG county funding is attached. The Administration on Aging has indicated that states should receive final funding for the FY 11 continuing resolution through September 30, 2011 by June 1. DAAS will provide SFY 11-12 allocations as soon as possible after the federal award is received and we have the opportunity to fully consider our probable state appropriations funding as of July 1. Our priority continues to be to avoid reductions, to the extent possible, in allocated funds to counties and this concern will take precedence over the timing of SFY 11-12 allocations.

This extends to Planning and Administration, State AAA Support, Title III Legal Services, Title III and VII Long-Term Care Ombudsman and Elder Abuse, III-D Disease Prevention and Health Promotion, and Family Caregiver Support. SFY 10-11 awards for these funds are attached.
