Public Comment	1 <sup>st</sup> <b>Sandra Wilson</b> - not present – Brandon Wilson chair – read comment that was sent in.: Transportation concerns and who is providing oversight- Issues include but are not limited to – Call back from providers, who are the providers, Consumers need a direct line to be able to contact. SCFAC plans to reach out to S Wilson – which MCO is she with, Standard Plan or Tailored Plan- and assist her with connecting with the correct people. 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2<sup>nd</sup>- **Dwight Hicks**- not present comment read by the chair-Concerns with Housing and the safety of it. Feels that he is not being heard concerning the need to move and get his children into a safer home. SCFAC - Nathan Cartwright will reach out and help connect with appropriate contacts. 3<sup>rd</sup> – **Chelsey Gray** – present to give her comment- felt disrespected that Deputy Secretary Ludlum had to leave early -(staff emailed her and let her know that he had been called into an emergency meeting which was out of his control) public comment was concerning the inconsistent hours that families are receiving families that have similar issues do not receive the same hours and feels that this inconsistencies is disrespectful to the medical staff, families and their loved ones. Families feel that they have no choice but to accept the reduced hours, and families feel bullied. The families that can afford lawyers are getting their issues handled but families that are not able to afford legal help are not getting assistance as quickly. 4<sup>th</sup> Suzanne Thompson CE&E Team lead – announced to the committee that the Chair and Co-chair of the SCFAC and the Chairs of the LCFAC have been invited to a new committee that will be working on the proposed changes that will be made to 122c. Suzanne clarified that if the MCO had more than one CFAC the Chair of the Steering Committee would be the one that receives the invite. 5<sup>th</sup> Crystal Foster SCFAC member- wanted to add to the public comment that was made by Chelsey Gray – She has continued to have issues within her area - there is only one company that provides PDN services in her area she has had to go sometimes 6 months without services. She received a call from her agency that they will need to discharge her son per a Medicaid policy. The agency was not able to give her the policy and at this time she was not able to locate this policy. Her son was discharged over the phone and has not received the written discharge with the appeals process. The company stated that they will continue to look for PDN services and reach back out to her if they locate them. Crystal plans to reach out to the DHB concerning this policy. Annette Smith made a committee that how each agency / MCO is interpreting the language of the Policies can affect the way services are provided. Having everyone interpret the policies the same could level the way families are affected by this.
