## REQUEST FOR APPLICATION No. DMH22-004BG-RFA

## **Questions and Responses**

- **Q)** Can multiple entities serve as the applicants for the proposal? For instance, a non-profit organization AND a clinical practice (for-profit) that meets all of the eligibility requirements set forth in section 2.0?
- **A)** One entity must be the contractor on the application and the other(s) will be subcontractor(s). Per Section 2.0 of the RFA, eligibility is open to non-profit providers only.
- **Q)** If multiple entities apply with one being a clinical partner with multiple locations across NC, must we pick one location to focus the work?
- **A)** No, it is not required that only one location be selected.
- **Q)** Is it sufficient for the clinical partner/applicant to serve the I/DD community in order to meet the requirement that the applicant "demonstrate partnership with an I/DD community provider at the point of application"?
- **A)** Per Section 5.1 of the RFA, the applicant must "Establish and maintain a relationship with at least one community-based non-SUD treatment agency that provides services to individuals experiencing I/DD."
- **Q)** Is there a specific age requirement of clients that must be met? Specifically, could the I/DD clients consist of children under 18yrs, understanding that a small percentage of adolescents may have SUD.
- **A)** Clients may be ages 12-17 and/or 18 and above, but the proposal must address how each population's needs will be separately met.
