







# GLOSSARY

**Disability** – A long-lasting physical, mental, or emotional condition that makes it difficult for a person to do activities such as walking, climbing stairs, dressing, bathing, learning, or remembering.

- Ambulatory Serious difficulty walking or climbing stairs
- Independent living Difficulty doing errands alone
- Hearing Deaf or having serious difficulty hearing
- Cognitive Difficulty remembering, concentrating or making decisions
- Self-care Difficulty bathing or dressing
- Vision Blind or serious difficulty seeing even with glasses

**Household** – A household includes all the people who occupy a housing unit as their usual place of residence. Household types are arranged into two groups. A family household contains at least 2 people, the householder and at least 1 other person related to the household by birth, marriage or adoption. A nonfamily household may contain only one person, the householder or additional people who are not relatives of the householder.

Householder – The person, or one of the people, in whose name the home is owned, being bought, or rented.

**Income** – "Total income" is the sum of the amounts reported separately for wages, salary, commissions, bonuses, or tips; self-employment income; interest, dividends, net rental income, royalty income, or income from estates and trusts; Social Security or Railroad Retirement income; Supplemental Security Income (SSI); any public assistance or welfare payments from the state or local welfare office; retirement, survivor, or disability pensions; and any other sources of income received regularly such as Veterans' (VA) payments, unemployment compensation, child support, or alimony.

**Labor force** – The labor force includes all people classified in the civilian labor force, plus members of the U.S. Armed Forces (people on active duty with the United States Army, Air Force, Navy, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard). The Civilian Labor Force consists of people classified as employed or unemployed.

**Median age** – Median age is the age at the midpoint of the population. Half of the population is older than the median age and half of the population is younger.

**Median income** – The median income divides the income distribution into two equal groups, one having incomes above the median, and other having incomes below the median.

**Poverty** – The Census Bureau uses a set of money income thresholds that vary by family size and composition to determine who is in poverty. If the total income for a family or unrelated individual falls below the relevant poverty threshold, then the family (and every individual in it) or unrelated individual is considered in poverty. The poverty threshold (2021) for a person 65 and older is \$12,996 and for two people (householder aged 65 and older) it is \$16,400.

**Race/Ethnicity** – The Census Bureau collects racial data in accordance with guidelines provided by the U.S Office of Management and Budget. The data is based on self-identification in which residents choose the race or races with which they most closely identify. **Hispanic or Latino** refers to an ethnic category, a person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South American or Central American or other Spanish culture or origin regardless of race.
