## 1 10A NCAC 06R .0502 NUTRITION

- 2 (a) An adult day program shall provide a midday meal to each participant in attendance. The meal shall provide at
- 3 least one-third of an adult's daily nutritional requirement as specified by the United States Department of Agriculture,
- 4 Dietary Guidelines for Americans, which are incorporated by reference, including any subsequent amendments or
- 5 additions to these guidelines. These guidelines may be viewed and downloaded from the Internet at
- 6 http://www.health.gov/dietaryguidelines/. A licensed dietician/nutritionist shall approve the menu.
- 7 (b) An adult day program shall offer snacks and fluids to meet the participant's nutritional and fluid needs. The adult
- 8 day program shall offer a mid-morning and mid-afternoon snack daily to participants. Snacks shall be planned to keep
- 9 sugar, salt and cholesterol intake to a minimum.
- 10 (c) An adult day program shall provide a therapeutic diet, if prescribed in writing by a physician, physician's assistant

11 or nurse practitioner for any participant. If therapeutic diets are prepared by program staff, such staff shall have

- 12 training in planning and preparing therapeutic diets or shall provide documentation of previous training and education
- 13 sufficient to assure ability to prepare meals in accordance with a physician's prescription.
- 14 (d) A licensed dietician/nutritionist shall give consultation to the staff on basic and special nutritional needs and
- 15 proper food handling techniques and the prevention of foodborne illness.
- 16 (e) An adult day care program shall neither admit nor continue to serve a participant whose dietary requirements
- 17 cannot be accommodated by the program.
- 18 (f) An adult day program shall store, prepare and serve meals in a sanitary manner using safe food handling techniques
- 19 such as those recommended by the United States Department of Agriculture, at the following website:
- 20 (http://www.fsis.usda.gov/Fact\_Sheets/Safe\_Food\_Handling\_Fact\_Sheets/index.asp). The food service provider shall
- 21 abide by the food safety and sanitation practices required by the Commission for Public Health rules applying to adult
- 22 day care facilities, including any subsequent amendments or additions, which are incorporated by reference. Copies
