10A NCAC 06R .0802 PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE

- 2 (a) A provisional certificate may be issued in accordance with the following:
- A provisional certificate may be issued by the Division of Aging <u>and Adult Services</u> when the certification renewal process identifies violations and a plan for corrective action is in place. The provisional certification will continue until timely corrections have been made and the division so informed, or until revoked.
 - (2) A provisional certificate may be issued by the Division of Aging and Adult Services when corrective action has not been completed by the completion date established in a corrective action plan. The provisional certification will continue until timely corrections have been made and the division so informed, or until revoked.
 - (3) A provisional certificate may be issued by the Division of Aging <u>and Adult Services</u> when renewal materials have not been submitted in a timely fashion, but were received by the division prior to the expiration date of the current period of certification. The provisional certificate will remain in place until revoked or until replaced with full certification.
 - (b) In no instance will a provisional certificate be in effect for longer than six months.
 - (c) When a provisional certificate is issued, the program must post a copy of the notice from the Division of Aging and Adult Services, identifying the reasons for it, adjacent to the current certificate.
