6	As used in this	Subchapter, unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the following terms have the meanings
7	specified:	
8	(1)	"Client" means any applicant for, or recipient of, public assistance or services, or someone who
9		makes inquiries, is interviewed, or is or has been otherwise served to some extent by the agency
10		For purposes of this Subchapter, someone acting responsibly for the client in accordance with
11		agency policy is subsumed under the definition of client.
12	(2)	"Agency" means the state Division of Social Services and the county departments of social services
13		unless separately identified.
14	(3)	"Client information" or "client record" means any information, whether recorded or not and
15		including information stored in computer data banks or computer files, relating to a client which
16		was received in connection with the performance of any function of the agency.
17	(4)	"Director" means the head of the state Division of Social Services or the county departments of
18		social services.
19	(5)	"Delegated representative" means anyone designated by the director to carry out the responsibilities
20		established by the rules in this Subchapter. Designation is implied when the assigned duties of ar
21		employee require access to confidential information.
22	(6)	"Court order" means any oral order from a judge or a written document from a judicial official which
23		directs explicitly the release of client information.
24	(7)	"Service provider" means any public or private agency or individual from whom the agency
25		purchases services, or authorizes the provision of services provided or purchased by other divisions
26		of the Department of Human Resources.
