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INTRODUCTION

In recent years there have been two separate reports(Annual Statistical Report for LMEs and the Admissions Report for LMEs) that have provided descriptive statistics and trends in the public community mental health system in North Carolina. In an effort to provide a single source of information that adequately describes the type of clients served at the clinical, demographic and geographic level these two reports have been combined into a single report for State Fiscal Year 2012. While similar in format and table construction to the previous reports, the intent of this report is to provide an integrated look at major service indicators and measures.

Client Activity and Utilization (Table I) reflects admission rates, active caseload at the beginning of the fiscal year, total admissions and the total number of persons served by LME. There were 166,373 active cases on July 1, 2011 and 126,635 total admissions (first and readmissions combined) during the fiscal year. A total of 293,008 persons were served during fiscal year 2012 as indicated by adding first and readmissions to the active cases (excluding those on Inactive Status and TASC Clients) on July 1, 2011. Graph 1 depicts the number of clients served at the LMEs for the last ten years. Please notice that this report reflects the name of the LME before merging July 1, 2012. The new MCO/LME name will be reflected in the FY2012-2013 annual report.

Admission rates reflect the total number of admissions to an LME during the fiscal year per 100,000 population in the catchment area. Admission rates are useful in that they allow comparisons among geographic areas as well as special population subgroups by adjusting the effects of population size. Admission rates were selected instead of utilization rates because of their greater accuracy.

The statewide admission rate was **1,310** admissions per 100,000 population. The admission rate ranged from a low of **150** per 100,000 reported by Onslow-Carteret to a high of **2,494** per 100,000 population reported by PBH .




TABLE 2

Table II reflects the number of persons served in each of the LME's by age and disability. The age of the client was calculated as of 6-30-12 and the disability of the client was based on the diagnosis assigned to the client on the IPRS/Medicaid paid claim.

A total of **315,284** persons were served in the LMEs during FY12. Persons Served, is calculated by totaling the active caseload on July 1, of the fiscal year (excluding those clients on Inactive Status) and all admissions.

Of the **315,284** clients served, **69** percent (**218,360**) were mentally ill, **6** percent (**20,170**) were developmentally disabled, and **24** percent (**76,754**) were substance abusers. Within each disability the percent of children served (0-17) ranged from 2 percent (**1,479**) of substance abusers, to **29** percent (**5,832**) of the developmentally disabled. The percent of children served in the mental health category was **18** percent (**55,451**).

Of the diagnosis reported at the time of admission, substance abuse (28,741) accounted for (20%). However, when looking at Psychiatric Diagnosis only, which represented (65.1%) of all diagnosis, major depressive disorders (16.4%) accounted for the most frequent diagnosis. Clients diagnosed with mental retardation accounted for 2,521 (1.8%) of all admissions while alcohol abuse accounted for 8.9%.

In the marital category the largest group are those who are single, representing **62.5%** of all admissions.

Of the **140,674** clients admitted, **67** percent (**94,683**) were mentally ill, **3** percent (**3,997**) were developmentally disabled, and **30** percent (**41,994**) were substance abusers. Within each disability the percent of children served (0-17) ranged from **3** percent (**1,297**) of substance abusers, to **36** percent (**1,444**) of the developmentally disabled. The percent of children served in the mental health category was **29** percent (**27,333**).

The relationships described for admission diagnosis remained true for termination diagnoses, although absolute numbers and percentages changed. Substance abuse accounted for **21.1** percent of terminations versus **20.4%** of admissions. Adjustment disorders accounted for 3.4 percent of terminations versus **4.7** percent of admissions while major depression disorders accounted for **15.2** percent versus **16.4** percent at admission.
