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This FY2012-2013 annual report on the three Psychiatric Hospitals is based on data extracted from the hospital's data system (HEARTS). The data extract is stored in the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Service's Client Data Warehouse (CDW). Data on hospital resident population, admissions, discharges and persons served are presented. Incorporated in the report are eight tables and one graph. Discharges are shown including mean and median length of stay. The number of persons served and the rate of persons served per 100,000 population is shown for each county in the state.

MAJOR SERVICE INDICATORS

Major service indicators for FY2012-2013 reported by the three hospitals show a a mixed trend in most indicators. The resident populations has shown a continuing decline since fiscal year 2003 .The number of admissions decreased over 599 from fiscal year 2012 to fiscal year 2013.


The number of persons served is the sum of the resident population and on leaves at the beginning of the fiscal year plus the number of admissions during the fiscal year. Table 2 shows the number of persons served by the three hospitals from each county in the state. Also shown for each county is the rate of persons served per 100,000 county population. Table 2-A shows the number of persons served by the three hospital's selected indicators.

The total hospital resident and on leave population is **(782)**. Table 3 presents breakdowns of the population by age, sex, race, commitment, and diagnosis. Residents with schizophrenia comprise over one-quarter of the total population. **11.6 percent** of the population is 65 years of age or older, **(65.1 %)** is male. **50.9** percent is non-white.

TOTAL ADMISSIONS

There were 3,210 admissions to the State Psychiatric Hospitals during fiscal year 2013.

The largest group of referrals **80.7** percent (**2,590**) were made by LME's (Local Management Entities), **5.7** percent (**173**) were self referred or referred by relatives, family or friends, while law enforcement referred over **5.9** percent (**190**). Involuntary admissions accounted for over **86.0** percent (**2,762**) of the total admissions for FY13.

Males constituted **60.3** percent **(1,935)** of the admissions. Of the total admissions percent **(47.4)** were non-white **22.1** percent **(711)** of the year's admissions had completed a high school education. Almost **5.5** percent **(177)** had completed eight years of schooling while only **2.6** percent **(83)** had completed four years of college or more.

DISCHARGES

Table 7 presents discharge information for the three psychiatric hospitals. The majority of discharges were direct (94.6 %). (**0.3** %) were indirect discharges while (**4.2** %) were transferred out to another facility. Deaths accounted for (**0.2** %) of discharges.

89.3 percent of all referrals for services at discharge were to LMEs.
