This FY2013-14 annual report on the three Neuro-Medical Treatment Centers is based on data extracted from the Neuro-Medical Treatment's data system (HEARTS). The data extract is stored in the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities and Substance Abuse Service's Client Data Warehouse (CDW). Data on Neuro-Medical Treatment resident population, admissions, discharges and persons served are presented (including individuals receiving respite services). The number of persons served and the rate of persons served per 100,000 population is shown for each county in the state. The Neuro-Medical Treatment Centers Report has been redesigned to reflect the data of all three Neuro-Medical Treatment Centers in the same table. This report only includes data on Inpatient Stays.

The data obtained from the Client Data Warehouse (CDW) database uses specific definitions and formulas. The Division of State Operated Healthcare Facilities (DSOHF) receives census reports directly from the developmental centers utilizing different definitions and formulas. It should be noted that the DSOHF and CDW reports are not consistent due to these different reporting requirements.

TOTAL ADMISSIONS

There were **225** admissions to the Neuro-Medical Treatment Centers during fiscal year 2014. This data includes duplicate admissions following community hospitalizations.

General Hospitals (Psych/Non Psych) represented **15.1%** of the referrals. Respite admissions accounted for over **51.6** percent (**116**) of the total admissions of FY14.

Females constituted **54.7** percent (**123**) of the admissions. Of the total admissions **21.8** percent (**49**) were non-white. **35.1** percent (**79**) of the year's admissions had completed a high school education. Almost **6.7** percent (**15**) last year of education was the eighth grade. **3.1** percent (**7**) had completed an associate degree.

The total neuro-medical treatment resident and on leave population is **(641)**. Table 3 presents breakdowns of the population by age, sex, race, commitment, and diagnosis. 46.5 percent of the population is 65 years of age or older, **(60.5%)** is male. **34.5** percent is non-white.
