SUBJECT: State/County Special Assistance Training

We are pleased to offer the annual statewide **State/County Special Assistance Training** in ten locations across the state in July and August 2004. This one-day workshop is designed specifically for SA caseworkers, SA supervisors, and agency training staff working in county departments of social services. This training will focus on the new Special Assistance monitoring plan that takes effect in August 2004, and on changes in SA policy and procedures implemented in the last year. It is important that each agency is represented at the training.

Jackie Franklin, SA Program Manager, will lead the workshop, along with the SA Program Compliance Representatives, Bettie Johnson and Sharon Odenwelder. County staff may register for whichever workshop location is most convenient. Each county may register up to 4 persons from their agency. The workshop begins with registration at 9:00 AM; training begins at 9:30 AM and ends by 3:30 PM. You may duplicate the enclosed registration form as necessary to accommodate the number of people attending the training, or you may register online at <u>www.ncswtrain.org</u>.

There is no registration fee for this workshop. **However, you must pre-register as space is limited at each site.** Please return your registration as soon as possible to ensure space availability at your chosen site. Registrants will be sent a confirmation letter, directions to the workshop site, and training site telephone contact number. Site locations were chosen to minimize overnight travel for participants.

Due to budget constraints, we regret that we are unable to provide refreshments at the breaks. Participants are welcome to bring their own snacks and beverages to the training event; in most of the training facilities snack and beverage machines are available.
