## Subject : An Introduction to Aging: Knowledge and Skills for Working With Older Adults and Their Families

I am pleased to inform you that An Introduction to Aging: Knowledge and Skills for Working with Older Adults and Their Families, will be conducted **October 25-26**, **2001 at the Ben Craig Center in Charlotte; December 10-11, 2001 at the Wake County Human Services in Raleigh; February 5-6**, **2002 at the New Hanover County Department of Social Services in Wilmington; and April 22-23**, **2002 at the Ramada Plaza in Asheville.** The curriculum was developed as part of the Division's contract with the Center for Aging Research and Educational Services (CARES). Co-sponsors of this workshop are the Division of Social Services and the Center for Aging Research and Educational Services (CARES), part of the Jordan Institute for Families at UNC-Chapel Hill School of Social Work.

The curriculum is a **two-day foundation course** designed to provide basic information and skills needed to work effectively with older adults and their families. The training is divided into four modules: Aging Processes, Group and Individual Differences, Change and Losses, and Practice Challenges.
