Procedures for working with minor mothers and fathers are clarified and the DSS-4540 revised to better document the participation of an adult representative for the minor parent. To access this information, select: minor client, interviewing and Alleged father, int. For a description of the revised DSS-4540, select: Minor parent statement.

CHAPTER D - Intake / Case Assignment and CHAPTER I - Paternity: Revisions are made to better clarify procedures for working with minor mothers and minor fathers. The participation of an adult representative in all interactions with minor parents is encouraged. Completion of the DSS-4540 Minor Parent / Adult Representative Statement is required to record the presence of the adult or decision by the minor to have no adult present.
