Dear County Director of Social Services and CSS Program Managers,

Section 15.6 of Senate Bill 897 (S.L. 2010-31), contains a correction to G.S. 110-134. This statute cites the filing fee for affidavits, agreements and orders under G.S. 110-132 and G.S. 110-133. Although the filing fee was increased from \$4.00 to \$6.00 in 2002, G.S. 110-134 was not revised to reflect the increased fee. Inclusion in this year's budget bill was merely to correct the oversight. There has been no change in the \$6.00 filing fee for a Voluntary Support Agreement.

Due to several changes, as well as some confusion regarding actual costs for certain actions, the following information clarifies costs related to frequent child support actions.

Miscellaneous Costs

- Paternity/Support agreements filing fee \$ 6.00 Clarifying legislation corrected a discrepancy between two statutes. Fee is unchanged.
- Application and Summons filing fee \$ 6.00 no change

Civil District Court Costs

- Civil Complaint \$100.00 effective 10/1/10
- Sheriff service of process fee \$ 15.00 no change

Consideration of budgetary impacts should be included when making a determination of the appropriate actions to be taken in a case.
