Dear County Director of Social Services and CSS Program Managers,

When child support enforcement services are terminated and a valid support order remains in effect, the case should be redirected to the Administrative Office of the Court (AOC). Prior to redirection and case closure, a motion in the cause must be filed if the order was established by Child Support Enforcement. The motion should specifically request that the Child Support Enforcement agency be removed as a part in the case and that the client be added as a party in the case. The responsible caseworker should solicit cooperation from the client prior to filing the motion.
