DEAR COUNTY DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL SERVICES

ATTENTION: ADOPTION SUPERVISORS AND SOCIAL WORKERS

We are pleased to inform you of a reorganization of Division staff who work directly with county DSS staff, private adoption agencies, Clerks of Court and private attorneys to review and index the required documents associated with completed adoptions. The purpose of the reorganization is to promote professional relations between these Division consultants and their colleagues in designated county areas. We also believe that this organizational structure will expedite the issuance of birth certificates by the Office of Vital Records.

Effective immediately, **Rosary Gross** is the Division's program consultant for reviewing and indexing legal adoption proceedings in counties 1-34, Alamance through Forsyth. **Sue Dickinson** is the program consultant for counties 35- 65, Franklin through New Hanover. **Karen Gonzalez** is the program consultant for counties 66-100, Northhampton through Yancey. They are working diligently to process all adoption documents on a timely basis and to reduce the backlog of pending cases. This is work that requires particular attention to detail and accuracy. The consultants will be available to provide on-site training to county DSS staff and Clerks of Court after July 1, 2001. All questions concerning legal adoption proceedings should be directed to the designated consultant.

In addition, two administrative support staff work with the consultants to enter adoption-related information into the Adoption Information Management System (AIMS). **Jo Anne Freeman** works with counties 1-50, Alamance through Jackson. **Christina Colon-Lanzolla** works with counties 51-100, Johnston through Yancey. <u>All calls concerning birth certificates should be directed to the appropriate administrative assistant</u>.

The consultants and administrative support staff can be reached at 919-733-3801. Someone is available between the hours of 7:30 A.M. and 5:30 P.M. Monday through Friday.

Since the Division reviews, indexes and enters information into AIMS for <u>all</u> child and adult adoptions in the state, these consultants and administrative assistants handle approximately 660 cases each month. The work generates a tremendous amount of written correspondence and over 150 phone calls per week. We are hopeful that the revised organizational structure will enhance our capacity to respond on a timely basis to your needs.

As in the past, questions about the Special Children's Adoption Fund, Special Children's Adoption Incentive Fund or adoption assistance should be directed to **Esther High** at (919) 733-4622. Questions about adoption policy and practice should be directed to your Children's Program Representative or to Esther High when your Children's Program Representative is unavailable.
