Dear County Directors of Social Services:

- Subject: Division of Social Services Reorganization Family Support and Child Welfare Services Section

It is with great pleasure that we announce the first of many steps in achieving our system reform efforts by the reorganization of two major service areas. The formation of the Family Support and Child Welfare Services Section will consolidate two previous distinct service areas into one area that will enhance the provision of services to families to achieve well-being through selfsufficiency, support, safety and permanence. In the past, the Children's Services Section and the Work First components of the Economic Independence Section operated as separate distinct program areas. The work of the newly created Family Support and Child Welfare Services Section will closely mirror the Multiple Response System (MRS) approach and the NCACDSS Family Net initiative. The formation of this section demonstrates the Division's commitment to system reform. The structure of The Family Support and Child Welfare Services Section includes the formation of seven functional teams. The seven functional teams are: Local Support Operations; Staff Development; Licensing and Policy; Data Management and Review; Work First and CPS Policy; Foster Care/Adoption Policy and Community Based Programs. Managers and some staff are assuming different roles, but while this transitioning process is occurring, many functions by staff, whom you have worked with in the past, remain the same. We have attempted through the organizational changes in the seven functional teams to place similar functions together, but our focus has been on the service integration and greater efficiencies in service delivery to families and children. Please find the attached with a list of the seven functional teams, a brief summary of their responsibilities and telephone numbers on how staff can be reached. As we transition into our new organizational structure, we will experience "some bumps" along the way and we ask for your patience.
