SUBJECT: CHILD CARE FACILITY ASSESSMENT PILOT

The Divisions of Social Services (DSS) and Child Development (DCD) have recently engaged in discussions surrounding the assessment of childcare facilities. In an effort to streamline these assessments and eliminate duplicative efforts, the two Divisions have discussed their respective roles and responsibilities.

Currently, allegations of abuse or neglect in childcare facilities involve DSS and DCD staff working collaboratively. To alleviate this duplication of work a proposal has been made to allow DCD to assume more responsibility for conducting assessments in child care facilities. Ultimately, the long term plan is that DSS would defer all assessments regarding child care facilities to DCD.

Your participation with a pilot to determine the feasibility of removing DSS from the assessment process is requested. The pilot will involve 13 counties and a four-month commitment beginning February 2010. Upon completion of the pilot, there will be an evaluation period before final recommendations would be made to the N.C. Department of Health and Human Services.

The design of the pilot has not yet been finalized. Therefore, your input into the design of the pilot is important. To accomplish this, both Divisions are requesting that each county identify a point of contact. We plan to host a meeting within the next couple of weeks to provide additional information.
