## SUBJECT: CHILD AND FAMILY SERVICES REVIEW/AGENCY'S SELF SURVEY

North Carolina's Child and Family Services Review instruments were updated December 2007 to reflect program and practice guidance from the Children's Bureau. The self survey has been updated to more accurately reflect North Carolina's child welfare practice. Key changes include an assessment of Multiple Response System strategies and System of Care (SOC) values. One SOC value that requires thoughtful assessment is cultural competence. North Carolina's Program Improvement Plan includes cultural competence as one of the overarching themes of our continuous improvement, and specifies the development of a cultural competence plan. The revised self survey allows for the careful consideration of data and practice and the development of a local plan to address any areas of concern. The questionnaire section of the self survey has also been revised to include questions regarding the use of group care and the determination of whether an intensive child fatality review occurred within the county since the last review.

The revised instrument is attached and will be effective March 1, 2009. All counties who receive notification of their on-site Child and Family Services Review on or after March 1, 2009 will be expected to complete the revised self survey.
