SUBJECT: MODEL COURT REPORTS FOR DISPOSITIONAL AND REVIEW PERMANENCY PLANNING AND POST ADOPTION TERMINATION OF PARENTAL RIGHTS HEARINGS

This letter is to inform counties of the availability online of "model court reports" for Dispositional and Review, Permanency Planning and Post Termination of Parental Rights Hearings. These model court reports represent the minimum requirements of information that should be provided to judges at these specific hearings. Counties may use their own format or alter these forms as they desire, provided that all of the required elements of information are included and presented to the judge.

These model court reports were developed by a work group consisting of county DSS staff, juvenile court judges, DSS attorneys, GAL attorneys, parent attorneys and court system staff. The development of model court reports is intended to strengthen our practice and is a part of our Program Improvement Plan resulting from the CFSR.
