SUBJECT: AUTOMATED CRIMINAL INFRACTION SYSTEM (ACIS) AND CIVIL CASE PROCESSING SYSTEM (VCAP) TRAINING

The North Carolina Division of Social Services would like to announce upcoming trainings on the Automated Criminal Infractions System (ACIS) and on the Civil Case Processing System (VCAP). The trainings will be conducted by Administrative Office of the Court (AOC) staff and are designated solely for the staff of the county departments of social services.

Please note that county staff have access to the ACIS and VCAP systems twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. The Division strongly recommends that criminal background checks be completed on all individuals sixteen years or older residing within the home, especially in those cases where there are concerns of family violence or concerns regarding social worker safety. For these reasons, the Division has contracted with AOC to train key child welfare staff, including after-hours staff on these two information systems.
