### SUBJECT: Revised Structured Documentation Instruments for CPS Assessments

In October 2010, the Children's Services Committee asked the North Carolina Division of Social Services to explore the formation of a workgroup for the purpose of streamlining and simplifying the workload within Child Welfare Services. In accordance with this request, the Division partnered with representatives from several local departments of social services to form what has commonly become known at the Simplification Workgroup. In the subsequent months, this workgroup has focused on certain forms that are a part of the everday practice of child welfare in North Carolina, with the first project being the Structured Documentation Instrument for CPS Assessments (DSS-5010).

The Simplification Workgroup members are pleased to announce that a revised instrument was approved for statewide use by the Children's Services Committee in March 2012. This instrument is required for use in all Child Protective Services Assessments beginning November 1, 2012.

Currently, the instrument has been made into an interactive form, which can be accessed from the Division's forms website at: <u>http://info.dhhs.state.nc.us/olm/forms/dss/dss-5010-ia.pdf</u>. The interactive form is set-up so that counties are able to save the form with only partial data entered as needed. This means that workers will be able to document their case activities as the case progresses and save that information each time they enter in new information.

In order to allow each county to convert the instrument into the format that best meets its own needs, a Microsoft Word version of the DSS-5010 will be made available to every agency via its director.
