SUBJECT: PRE-APPROVAL LETTERS FOR INTERNATIONAL ADOPTIONS

We are pleased to inform you that effective immediately, letters of pre-approval from the North Carolina Division of Social Services Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children (ICPC) office will no longer be necessary for international adoptions. Pre-placement assessment should continue to be forwarded to the United States Citizen and Immigration Services (USCIS) office. The ICPC office does not need a copy of this pre-placement assessment.

Historically, standard procedure required that pre-placement assessments for families adopting internationally would be forwarded to the ICPC office. Subsequently, this office would forward a pre-approval letter to the USCIS office. With this change, our office will not issue pre-approval letters as standard practice.
