SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION REALLY IS POSSIBLE (TRIP) PROGRAM

PURPOSE / BACKGROUND

The purpose of this letter is to provide county child welfare agencies with financial information, criteria updates, and promotional materials about the Transportation Really Is Possible (TRIP) program.

OTHER INFORMATION

Revised Criteria

The TRIP program criteria have been updated to clarify that young people do not have to incur driving-related costs to be eligible for assistance through TRIP. County child welfare agencies may pay for an eligible cost on behalf of the young person and receive reimbursement from the State. However, if a young person has incurred a cost for an eligible driving-related expense, they may request reimbursement from the county through the TRIP program.

Financial Information

The Division has reclassified \$25,057.30 of prior LINKS Transitional expenditures reimbursed to counties between July 1, 2017 and March 15, 2018 from LINKS Transitional Funds to TRIP. These expenditures were made on behalf of TRIP-eligible youth and young adults for TRIP-eligible costs such as vehicle insurance, driver's education, driver's license and permit fees, and vehicle history reports.

The reclassification and May reimbursements bring the TRIP program balance to \$44,220 as of June 15, 2018. From now until the end of the state fiscal year, June 30, 2018, be sure to utilize TRIP program funds for driving-related costs on behalf of eligible youth and young adults, instead of using LINKS Transitional funds for this purpose. Please note that the new state fiscal year begins July 1, 2018 and both program funds will renew at that time.

Promotional Materials

Attached to this letter are materials that counties may use to promote the TRIP program. These materials may be printed for display in county departments of social services and for distribution among youth in foster care, foster parents, Guardian ad Litems and other stakeholders. The .pdf file formats may be displayed or posted online. The .jpg file formats are for printing only.
