SUBJECT: INTERSTATE COMPACT ON THE PLACEMENT OF CHILDREN (ICPC)

PROGRESS REPORTING

The purpose of this letter is to emphasize the necessity of progress reports as it relates to achieving permanency for children in cases involving the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children (ICPC).

Public Law 109-239, which be viewed accessing following can by the http://icpc.aphsa.org/Home/home news.asp, requires that in-state and out-of-state placement are options in permanency hearings. Furthermore, if a child is already in an out-of-state placement, the permanency hearing must determine if the placement continues to be appropriate and in the child's best interest. ICPC policy further indicates that throughout the child's placement in another state, progress reports are to be submitted by the sending agency to the North Carolina ICPC office in accordance with the frequency requested on the ICPC Form 100-A. Reports should include a clear statement that the sending agency must retain jurisdiction, unless or until the time a recommendation for transfer of legal custody to the placement resource or termination of jurisdiction is appropriate.
