This MRS Learning Institute is an extension of the training programs and technical assistance activities the Division provides to the 100 county Departments of Social Services and multiple community partners. The theme this year is *Partnerships Taking Flight* and we would like to extend an invitation to our partners to participate by submitting a workshop proposal.

This Institute is designed to provide high quality training for beginning and experienced professionals with a special emphasis on developing Family Centered Principles and System of Care skills sets. This includes such concepts as utilizing community-based prevention services, collaborating with community partners, recognizing strengths, meeting the needs of families utilizing strengths, and increasing partnership development with families. We encourage workshop proposals that highlight the partnership between Departments of Social Services staff, families, foster and adoptive parents, and community partners. Your workshop can range from 1.5 hours in length to 5 hours in length and it should promote active participation by attendees and skills building opportunities. We anticipate the ability to cover many of the expenses incurred as part of training at this Institute which include many meals as well as possible travel reimbursement, hotel costs and/or a stipend.
