SUBJECT: EMPLOYMENT SECURITY COMMISSION EMPLOYER INCENTIVES

Staff from the State Employment Security Commission (ESC) has provided important information that can be valuable in assisting Work First recipients in locating employment and in strengthening relationships with local employers. The ESC staff has provided information on two programs:

- 1. Work Opportunity Tax Credit Program
- 2. Federal Bonding Opportunities

The Work Opportunity Tax Credit Program offers employer tax incentives for hiring Work First recipients. The Federal Bonding Program enhances the employability of a potential employee by offering additional bonding protection in the amount of \$5,000 per individual. For further guidance on these two (2) programs, please refer to the attachments. The Division and the ESC are working together to enhance collaboration and to increase the state s Work Participation Rates.
