RE: Treatment of TANF-Funded Subsidized Employment Income

Dear County Director of Social Services:

On March 26, 2010, USDA issued a memorandum regarding the treatment of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) subsidized employment income for Food and Nutrition Services purposes. FNS does not treat subsidized employment as public assistance and therefore will treat TANF-funded subsidized employment as earned income.

This policy is effective as of March 26, 2010 and includes all TANF-funded subsidized employment paid to FNS clients or applicants in the form of wages, regardless of the source of TANF funding, including but not limited to, funds available through the Emergency Contingency Fund for State TANF programs.
