RE: FNS Case Backlog

Dear County Director of Social Services:

The Department recognizes that counties may have FNS cases that have not been completed and benefits have not been issued to households on their regular issuance date.

The State is currently in the process of hiring 161 temporary state employees that will be trained and have the ability to complete case work in NC FAST. Once the state temporary staff has been trained, they will be deployed to all 100 county DSS agencies.

A team of NC FAST support staff has been assigned to focus exclusively on assisting in processing any backlog of cases.

Counties that have a significant backlog will be given the opportunity to send completed recertification packets on overdue cases to Raleigh for State temporary staff to process.
