RE: Program Integrity-Treasury Offset Program (TOP) Refunds

Dear County Director of Social Services:

As a result of the recent Management Evaluation conducted by USDA, it was determined, due to a technical error in EPICS, that a small number of debtors for Food and Nutrition Services claims were intercepted for federal income tax returns too soon. Although the intercepts occurred too soon, the claim was correctly established and is valid. USDA has mandated that all clients that were intercepted in error be offered a choice to either receive a refund of the amount intercepted or allow the money to remain on the claim.

The attached letter will be mailed to all clients impacted by this error by September 30, 2014. You may receive phone calls from clients concerning these letters. It is important to allow the client to make the choice, but inform them the claim balance will revert back to the amount prior to the interception and they will still owe money on the claim if they choose to have a refund issued.
