Energy Outreach Plan Follow-Up

To help maximize spending and to amplify the success of the Energy program, counties develop outreach plans each year. The plan is to ensure that eligible households are made aware of the assistance and availability of the Crisis Intervention Program (CIP), Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP), and Weatherization Program.

To ensure county outreach plans are being implemented and to track the process of the plans, quarterly follow up will be conducted. Each county needs to complete this form and return to their State Energy Consultant by designated deadline.

- 1. County Outreach Committees should meet at least twice a year. Has your county committee been holding meetings? If so, when was the last meeting and the discussion/topic?
- 2. How effective has your outreach plan been? Has your county expended at least 70% of your CIP and/or LIEAP funding? If not, how can you help citizens utilize these programs more?
- 3. Any additional comments, concerns about your County's outreach plans? Any suggestions on how the State can better support the success of your outreach efforts outside of the normal press releases, flyers, brochures, and media communications?
