USDA has approved North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (NC DHHS) FNS Outreach Plan for FY 2012.

North Carolina will have four contractual partners: North Carolina State University, NC Association of Feeding America Food Banks, Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina and MANNA Food Bank. There are five non-contractual partners: North Carolina Division of Aging, North Carolina Employment Security Commission, The Coalition to Reduce Hunger in Brunswick County, Ashe Services for Aging and The High Country Area Agency on Aging. All partner agencies will provide an array of outreach services to potentially eligible individuals and families ranging from passing out brochures to assiting with application completion.

Households choosing application assistance through the FNS outreach partner agencies will have the options to submit their application through the partner agency, in person, by an authorized representative, by fax, or by mail to their local DSS agency.
