Today, the U.S. Department of Agriculture released the official Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) overpayment, underpayment, and payment error rates for Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 under the quality control (QC) provisions of Section 16(c) of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008, as amended (the Act). The national performance measure (national average payment error rate) for FY 2018 is 6.80 percent. Your payment error rate consists of the sum of the overpayment rate and the underpayment rate. Please note, this sum may not add up to the exact payment error rate due to rounding.

North Carolina's QC error rates for FY 2018 are:

Overpayment Rate

3.74 percent

Underpayment Rate

1.23 percent

Payment Error Rate

4.97 percent

The Southeast Regional Office is your partner in reducing payment error rates. The Food Nutrition Service recognizes your efforts to improve your payment error rate over the past fiscal year. Your State FY 2018 payment error rate of 4.97 percent reflects a reduction from the FY 2017 rate of 5.25 percent. We appreciate the focus and importance you have placed on this high priority issue. As we work together to continuously improve payment accuracy, we also remain dedicated to the validity and accuracy of the QC system as a whole.
